Constitution & Rules to be followed.

Name - England Inclusio Darts Association

- EIDA games will follow our very own (disability darts rules and format) League games will be - best of 5 legs (*first to 3*) during the Round Robin stage.
- Once the Round Robin is complete, players if qualified advance to the knockout stage, where it remains best of 5 until the **Semi Final** which is **best of 7** (*first to 4*) and the **final** is **best of 9** (*first to 5*).
- All players will complete over the season to attain league points for our own internal Order of Merit system. This table will be used to determine which players are picked for England Team selection during international team events.
- EIDA are affiliated to other organisations namely World ParaDarts (WPD) and World Inclusio ParaDarts.

EIDA will not tolerate any negative, aggressive or other behaviour deemed to bring us into disrepute, all players, volunteers and visitors are expected to adhere to our code of conduct and noncompliance may see a person (s) asked to leave and could result in termination of their membership.

Aims and objectives.

- EIDA aims to be totally inclusive of all disabilities and full-time carers, we will do our utmost to accommodate, however this will depend on the severity of disability and how that affects a person's ability to play darts (safely).
- To promote the sport of disability darts in England and across the world.
- To ensure a duty of care to all members.
- To provide all its services and treatment in a way that is fair to everyone.

Membership.

Memberships are yearly.

****Membership starts from January of each year, regardless of month joined****

Upon becoming a member, this is confirmation that you accept our regulations and codes of conduct that have been adopted and the policies and rules of EIDA.

Membership fees.

Membership fees will be decided at the annual general meeting, each year. All monies will stay within EIDA to provide venues, equipment and anything else required to establish and run the league.

Membership fees for England Inclusio Darts Association are as follows: £10 per year, and Membership to World Inclusio ParaDarts is £10 per year – So £20 yearly is payable.

Finance.

All monies will be banked into the EIDA's bank account, the treasurer will be responsible for the banking and book keeping of EIDA, and will be expected to provide financial updates at our yearly AGM.

All finances will remain transparent, at all times, members must put their request in writing and allow a 30-day period to view accounts.

Annual general meetings (AGM)

Notice of AGM will be given by the chairperson.

Discipline and appeals.

All complaints regarding the behaviour and any breaches, should be submitted in writing, to the committee, the committee will meet to hear complaints within 14 days of a complaint being made. The committee has the power to take appropriate disciplinary action, including termination of membership.

The outcome of the complainant's issue (s) will ensure those involved, are given the outcome within 14 working days.

League games, events and tournaments.

- There will be a minimum of 10 league meetings a year (EIDA) this does not include extra dates for World Inclusio ParaDarts competitions within England. However, that will depend on numbers that are registered and attend on the dates given, if numbers are low then EIDA reserve the right to withdraw sessions.
- Each league player will play each as part of the Round Robin format, the same format that World ParaDarts use during competitions. The round robin will consist of group(s) of players who will all play each other, when all results are completed the top 2 players from each group will qualify for the knockout stage. The knockout stage will begin and end by crowning a session winner for that month.

EIDA believe that by doing this new format, it is giving the players relevant practice and experience, not only this it is also teaching players the correct format for when attending ranking events across the Inclusio Calender.

Dissolution.

In the event of any dissolution of EIDA, all equipment will be sold, or returned to sponsors, all equipment owned by EIDA will then be sold, at this point all debts and bills will need to be paid to cover costs, any finances left after this, all remaining monies will be split equally between Members of the Organisation.
